

2021-2022 WJES Club Options

Clubs are a wonderful way for students to participate in activities outside of the regular school day that enrich their learning and development. WJES is excited to offer a variety of clubs for students at our school. Descriptions for each club are listed on this form. If your child is interested in participating in a club, fill out and submit the Google Form, linked at the bottom, by **Wednesday, October 27th**. If you have multiple children interested in clubs, please fill out one form for each child. Club sponsors will contact you with more information about whether or not your child has been selected for the club of their choice and important information about when their club will begin.

WJES Club Guidelines:

- (1) Club pick-up time is 3:30. Students not picked up by 3:45 P.M. will need to be supervised under the care of the WJES After-School Program. Appropriate fees will be charged for any students who stay in the after-school program.
 - \$7 per day
 - \$1 per minute after 6:00 P.M.Please let the advisor know if your child is already registered and should go to ASP when the club meeting ends. (Space is limited in ASP).
- (2) Due to the number of clubs available at WJES, **students may participate in ONE CLUB**. In an effort to accommodate as many students in clubs as possible, we ask that students indicate their first, second, and third choice of clubs on the Google Form linked at the bottom of this form.
- (3) Attending club meetings is a privilege. Students are expected to follow school rules and procedures during club meetings, just as they are during the school day. Any students who have inappropriate behavior at school, on the bus, or cause disruption at club meetings, may be removed from the club at the discretion of the advisor.
